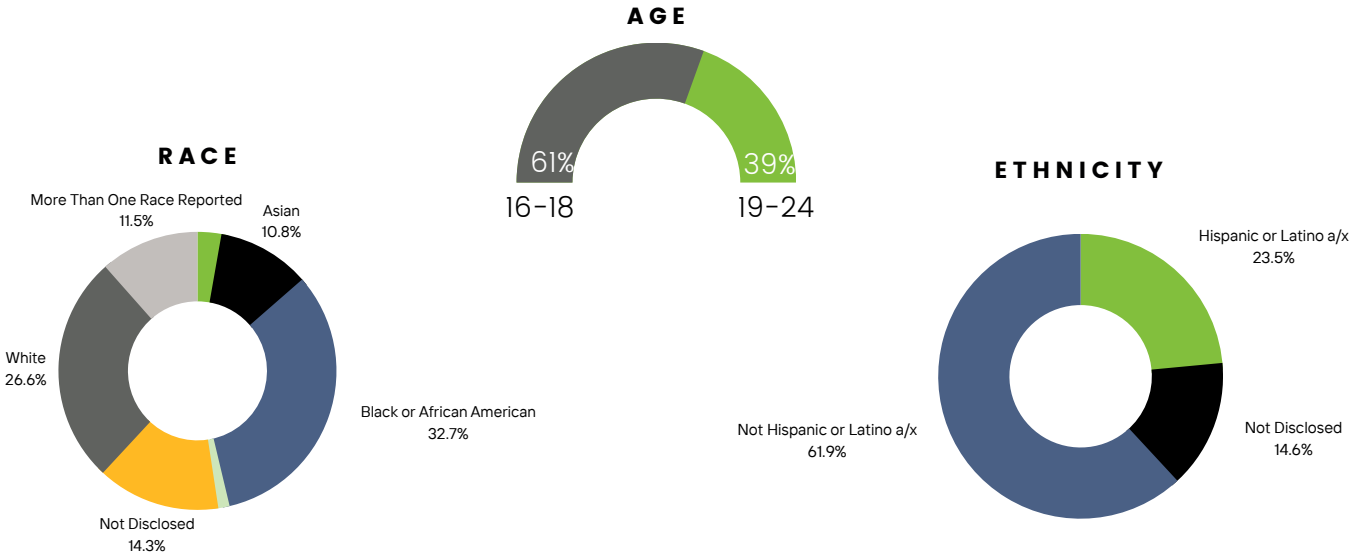


SummerWorks | June - September 2023

- 11% of Participants are from Immigrant and/or Refugee Families

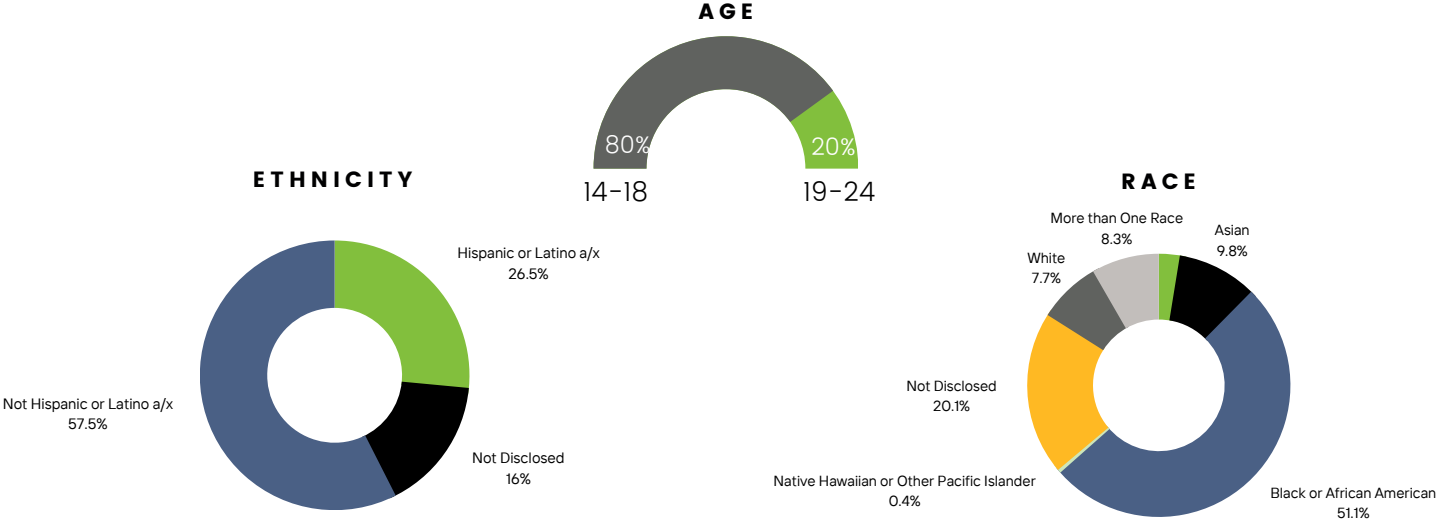
Post Program Plans
